

CLASS SESSIONS:

Alien's, UFO's & Monsters –301

Students will use their imagination to draw, paint and sculpt original aliens, UFO's and monsters.

Animals Animals Animals—111

Have fun being other animal lovers as you learn basic techniques to draw, paint and sculpt your favorite animals and creatures!

Art Explosion--101

Young Artists explore their creativity with an explosion of fun art materials and projects! Paint, sculpt, draw, glue and more. Please have your child wear a paint shirt to class.

Art in Nature—145

Students will go on a hike to gather items to use in their projects. The class will make leaf prints, fish prints, collage art, wind chimes, stepping stones, sketch journals, bird drawing and watching and various other projects using natural items. The class will also hike to the ND Heritage Center.

Art of Harry Potter Mini Camp—235

If you are a fan of the Harry Potter books or movies you will love this class. Come expecting to be sorted into houses & work hard to win the house cup! Create your own wands & wand boxes, brew up some interesting potions, make spell books, sculpt your favorite magical creature, visit Honey Duke's sweet shop, plant something interesting in herbology, play Quidditch & lots more! Includes new magical projects & adventures different from last year.

Art of Mythology, Legend and Fantasy—335

We will use stories from Greek mythology, the Percy Jackson book series and legends to inspire a variety of art making and project ideas! Draw, paint or sculpt monsters, beasts and mighty heroes. Make your own personal adventure: create your own Pandora's box, get the Midas touch with gold spray paint, draw a map to another realm or craft a powerful amulet...it's up to you! Includes some new projects different from last year.

Basic Drawing—231

Learn the basics of drawing which is the foundation of all art making. Discover drawing with different types of drawing media.

Cartooning—351

Students will learn basic cartooning techniques and learn some fundamentals in drawing faces and caricatures. Each child will learn what it takes to bring life to their cartoon character.

Cherry Blossom Geisha—110, 230, 310

Come to the Orient through learning to paint on a Kimono and Obi made especially for you! Students will learn about the Japanese culture and wear their beautiful Kimono during a special Tea Ceremony. *Only requirement is when you register, please include your size.

Colored Pencils—341

Students will learn basic colored pencil techniques and learn how to apply them in creating their drawing. Watch your drawings become vibrant and full of energy. Great class for the student who loves color.

Creative Clay—122

Students will learn basic hand-building techniques to make functional and non-functional projects. Students will learn the basic techniques of coil, pinch and slab. The class will look at a variety of clay pieces for inspiration.

Creative Clay and Claymation—141

Explore the world of modeling clay—learn how to work three dimensionally and sculpt simple creatures, people, structures and scenes. Use your skills to create simple stop motion animated shorts of your creations!

Creative Japanese Wall Hangings. 130, 250, 320

Students learn the beautiful world of Japanese Shibori (Tie-Dye) and they will make beautiful wall hangings. Students will learn how to paint on the dyed silk fabric to create stunning art designs to grace your home.

Creative Sculpture—322

Students will explore several forms of sculpture and media. Learn some basics and explore the creativity. Students may use foam, wood, wire, clay, cardboard or other materials in creating sculpture.

Drawing Cartoons and Comics—131

Cartoons can be anything—people, animals, food or objects! Have fun and explore simple ways to use your imagination to create your own characters, expressions, features and personalities for your characters. Learn ways to turn them into simple comic strips and comic books if you wish!

Draw, Paint and Collage—112

A variety of supplies will be used and a little creativity in cutting and gluing to make collage pieces of art. The class will explore torn paper, magazine images and scraps of paper. Painting and drawing will also be used in this expressive class.

Draw, Paint and Sculpt Animals—245

Students learn how to use basic shapes when drawing animals. The class will learn to apply textures, color and value to the painted animal. Students will also have the opportunity to sculpt their favorite animals.

Drawing & Painting Animals—100

Students learn how to draw animals, from family pets to exotic animals of all types. They will also learn how to paint animals using watercolors. This class is designed for the beginner student and also for students who want to improve their drawing and painting skills.

Drawing Dinosaurs and Making Fossils—215

A great class for the child who loves science and art. Students will be taught basic drawing techniques. Drawing, Painting and Sculpting will be emphasized in class. The class will also walk to the ND Heritage Center to explore the dinosaur gallery.

Egyptian Creations—220

Students will learn how to draw on special Egyptian papyrus paper, make an Egyptian mask and a write in Egyptian letters, discovering the unique mysteries of their culture.

Exploring Watercolor—331

Students will learn basic watercolor techniques and use watercolor pencils and other media. The class will look at such artists as Homer, Wyeth and Paul Klee for inspiration. A great class for experimentation.

Fancy Fairy Club—200

Fun class for little girls and boys to decorate a costume and fairy objects to dress up and enjoy themselves. Each child will learn to paint and use stamps to create unique designs on their costumes. Please include child's size when registering for this class.

Fantasy Masks—300

Students have a fun time creating unique masks using molds and painting and decorating their masks with a variety of materials, ribbon, glitter, features, etc.

Fun Creations for Your Room—321

Use your creativity to craft fun things to bring life to your room! Create your own bulletin boards, unique storage containers, picture frames, wall decorations and more!

Geisha Accessories—120, 240, 350

Every Geisha has her accessories to complete her outfit which students will paint their own umbrella, chop sticks and fans.

Glass Etching—150, 210, 330

Create wonderful glass designs by etching glass. Students will make a small hanging ornament and etch a large mirror tile. Students can also bring items like glasses to etch which can serve a functional purpose and still have fun.

Japanese Zen Gardens—140, 340

Students will learn the beautiful world of the Japanese Zen Gardens by creating their own special Zen Garden. They will also learn how to create objects to use in their garden and learn the benefits of such a peaceful art form.

Musical Theatre Performance—133,232, 332

A pre-professional class focusing specifically on the art form of interpreting and analyzing singing, acting and the physical performing skills.

Musical Theatre Vocal Techniques—114

Bring a song to life! Constructive coaching will help with the interpretation and delivery of a show tune of your choice.

Nature Art—311

The natural world around us has so much to teach. Use and collect things from nature to create art. Paint and draw the trees outside, landscapes, flowers and birds. Sculpt or collage something interesting with natural materials.

Oil Pastel and Mixed Media—312

Learn basic techniques and explore color theory in designing unique expressions with oil pastel. A fun class to explore color, design and expression. Students will chose what to draw.

Painting Studio—121

Explore the world of paint as you learn basic and more adventurous techniques with acrylic, watercolors and ink. Spray, brush, drip or swat color on with a variety of brushes and tools. Self-expression is encouraged!

Scribbling, Splattering and Splashing—102, 201

Let's scribble, splatter and splash outside the borders. Students will be using drawing and painting materials. A great class for the child to discover materials and self-expression.

Storybook Theatre I—103, 202, 302

Storybook Theatre II—113, 211, 313

Students will create their own show from scratch and perform it on Friday for parents and friends.

Tie Dye—132

Bring a 100% cotton item the first day of class. Learn the basics of how to tie-dye your own clothing and other fabrics.
